Interior Health targets high-transmission neighbourhoods

IH Wide – Interior Health is accelerating COVID-19 immunizations for people aged 30 and over in two communities seeing high-transmission: the District of Summerland and the Rutland neighbourhood in Kelowna.

People living in these communities born in 1991 or earlier and are registered to get vaccinated will soon be invited to book appointments.
