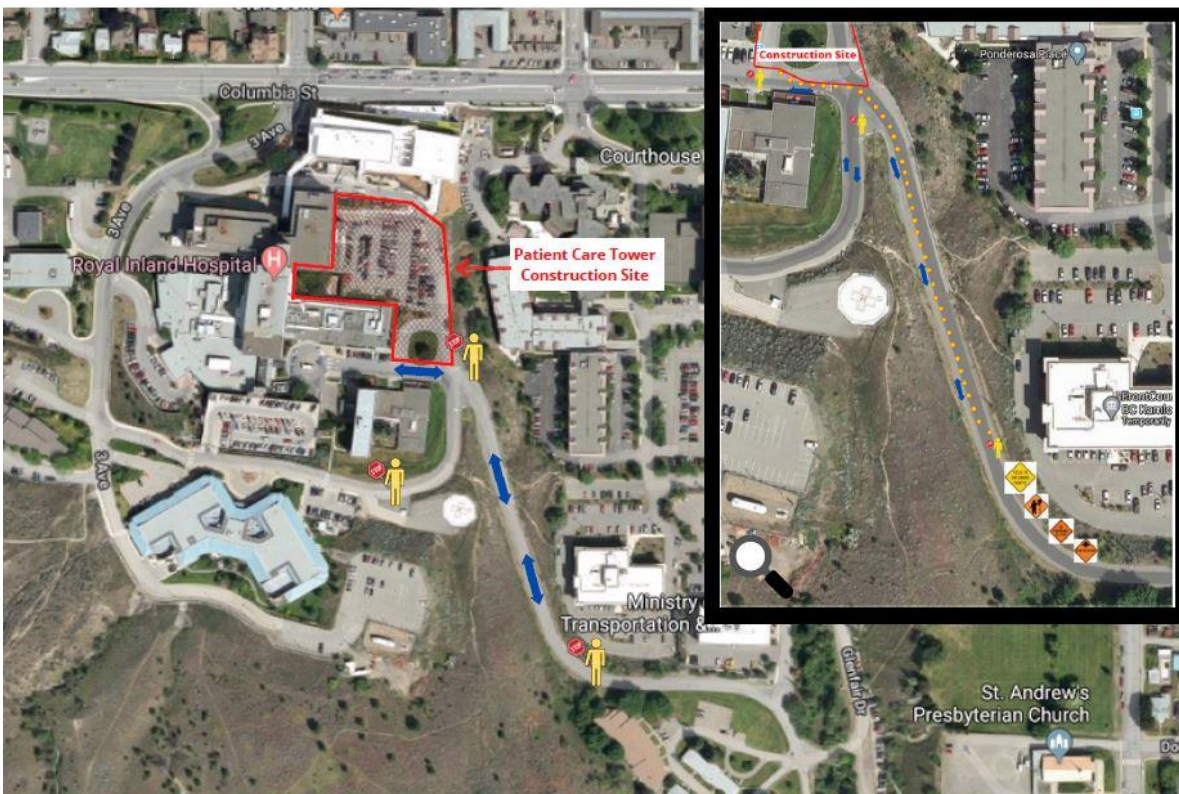
Temporary traffic pattern change for Royal Inland Hospital patients

KAMLOOPS – As part of the ongoing construction of the Royal Inland Hospital (RIH) Patient Care Tower, patient access to RIH will be temporarily changed beginning Monday, Sept. 21, 2020.

A section of Ring Road by the patient drop-off area near the coffee shop and the Patient Care Tower construction site will be down to single-lane traffic to allow for a crane to lift generators to the ninth floor of the Patient Care Tower.

The work will take place during day-time hours, however the road will remain single-lane traffic 24 hours per day from Sept. 21 to 23, 2020. Traffic control flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.
