RIH Clinical Services Building elevators back in service

KAMLOOPS – Elevators at Royal Inland Hospital’s Clinical Services Building (CSB) are up and running, with repairs completed as of Friday night.

The elevators experienced an unexpected equipment failure on Jan. 17, resulting in a temporary change to parking at RIH.

Regular parking resumes

Beginning immediately, RIH patient/visitor paid parking returns to the public parkade in the CSB. Staff and physician passholder parking returns to the staff parkade behind the hospital.

Signage will be in place to direct public back to the CSB parkade. Drivers should note that this parkade is strictly for patients and visitors while they are conducting business at Royal Inland Hospital.

Interior Health thanks patients, visitors, physicians and staff for their co-operation during the past eight days.

The CSB is located at the front of the Columbia Street hospital campus and includes parking and various outpatient clinical services.

Services within the CSB:

- Level 2: Outpatient clinics - Lab, pre-surgical screening, pulmonary function, cardiology, neurology, Vascular Improvement Program, IV therapy/ID clinic/PICC clinic, and rapid access clinics.
- Level I: Outpatient clinics - Telehealth, orthopaedic clinic, TRFO – Thompson Region Family Obstetrics Clinic (maternity), Rae Fawcett Breast Health Clinic, Rae Fawcett Simulation Centre, as well as the Ken Lepin Lecture Theatre, and UBC Faculty of Medicine.
- Level P1 includes the Urgent Primary Care and Learning Centre.
- Levels P1 to P4 are parking for patients and visitors to RIH,
