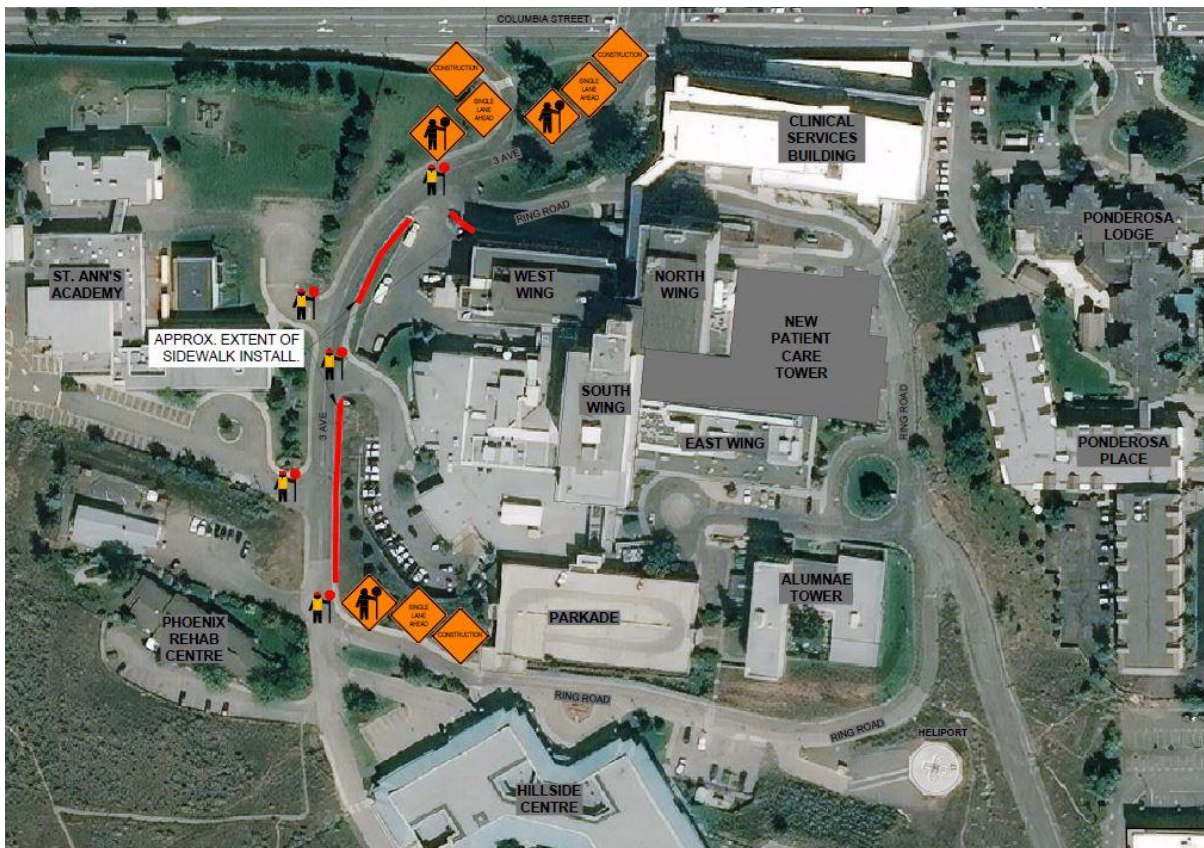
RIH sidewalk construction to reduce road to single lane

KAMLOOPS – People attending Royal Inland Hospital (RIH) in Kamloops from June 14-22 should be aware of construction that will reduce 3rd Avenue to single-lane traffic only.

As part of the RIH Patient Care Tower Project, crews will be working on a new sidewalk along 3rd Avenue (see map for details). People with appointments at the hospital on these dates may wish to consider allowing extra time to reach their destinations.

The work is scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. from June 14-22. The road will remain open to single-lane traffic and traffic control flaggers will be in place to help direct vehicles and pedestrians.
