## Rutland hosts outdoor neighbourhood immunization clinic May 26

KELOWNA –In partnership with the City of Kelowna, the Uptown Rutland Business Association and the Rutland Resident Association, Interior Health is hosting a neighbourhood immunization clinic in Rutland today.

No advance appointments are necessary for this clinic. People who live or work in Rutland will be able to walk-up, register and receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

Location:	Rutland Centennial Park, 190 McIntosh Road
Time:	Wednesday, May 26 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.
Who:	People in the Rutland area who are born in 2009 or earlier, and who have not
	yet received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Rutland residents who are not able to attend the neighbourhood clinic can still receive a vaccine locally.

Interior Health has two nearby immunization clinics: Rutland Centennial Hall (215 Shepherd Road) offers appointments five days per week, Monday to Friday; and Trinity Hall (1905 Springfield Road) offers vaccine appointments seven days a week.
