Temporary visitor restrictions at Royal Inland Hospital

KAMLOOPS – The public is advised that temporary visitor restrictions are now in place at Royal Inland Hospital due to COVID-19 activity at the facility. Effective immediately, only essential visitors will be able to attend the site.

Essential visitors includes those coming to Royal Inland Hospital for:

- Visits for compassionate care: including critical illness, palliative care, hospice care, end-of-life and medical assistance in dying;
- Visits to patients in the emergency department or intensive care unit;
- Visits for pediatric care, labour and delivery;
- Visits necessary to support a patient’s physical care (e.g., assistance with feeding or mobility), mental well-being, or decision-making.

These temporary visitor restrictions are in place as a precautionary measure due to current COVID-19 outbreak activity at the hospital.

All services continue to be available at Royal Inland Hospital and the hospital remains safe to visit for anyone needing emergency care.
