<b>Looks like:</b>	WHITE GRANULES WITH COLOURED FLECKS
<b>Sold as:</b>	CRACK
<b>Contains:</b>	CRACK COCAINE AND FENTANYL
<b>Risk:</b>	OVERDOSE RISK IS HIGH WHEN STIMULANTS ARE MIXED WITH FENTANYL.
<b>In effect until:</b>	FEBRUARY 18, 2022

No matter what or how you use (smoking, snorting, injecting) take steps to prevent overdose:

- Get your drugs checked – find locations at [drugchecking.ca](https://www.drugchecking.ca)
- Any drug, including stimulants like cocaine and meth, can be contaminated with fentanyl
- Use Fentanyl Test Strips to test your drugs for the presence of fentanyl
- Be aware of the increased risks that come from mixing with other substances
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site (OPS).
- Start with a small amount
- Carry naloxone and know how use it.
