

## **Nelson and Castlegar**

DOWN with high concentration of fentanyl, fentanyl analogue and benzodiazepine



When using with others, space out your doses!

Looks Like: Yellow and Green Chunks and Pebbles

Sold as: Down, Fentanyl

Contains: High concentration of <u>fentanyl</u> and and <u>fentanyl</u>

<u>analogue</u>. Higher than average concentration.

Positive for <u>benzodiazepines</u>

Risk: High risk of overdose, High risk of fatal overdose.

Mixing with alcohol can be especially dangerous.

Focus on breathing if naloxone appears to not resolve

overdose symptoms.

Using in the cold increases chances of overdose.

In effect until: December 28th 2022

## Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Smoking is not safer than injecting, be cautious when smoking your drugs
- Find drug checking locations at www.drugchecking.ca
- Be aware that benzodiazepine induced sedation is not reversible by naloxone
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site (OPS)
- Start with a small amount and space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it
