



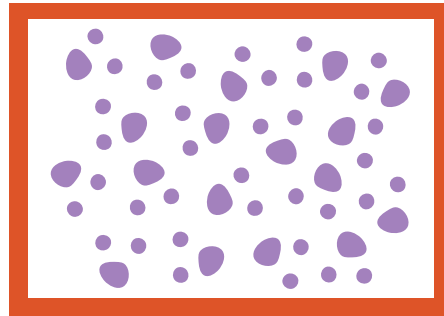

Trail



Purple substance sold as **DOWN** contains carfentanil



- Looks Like: Purple Chunks or Pebbles
- Sold as: Down, Dope, Pants, Fentanyl
- Contains:
 - 0.5% Carfentanil ⚠️
 - 33% Fentanyl ⚠️
 - 25% Bromazolam ⚠️
 - Caffeine and mannitol (sugar) as buffs
- Risk:
 - Extreme risk of overdose
 - Extreme risk of fatal overdose
 - Prolonged sedation and amnesia
- In effect until: December 20th 2024

Carfentanil is 50 to 100X the strength of fentanyl. The strength of this sample is equivalent to upwards of 83% fentanyl.

Hotspots can be very dangerous with carfentanil. Make sure your dope is well mixed.

Bromazolam is a strong benzodiazepine which can cause amnesia and prolonged sedation.

Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find drug checking locations at www.drugchecking.ca ←
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it. Carfentanil will respond to naloxone.
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around when possible
- Start with a small amount and space out your doses
