



Dental and Oral Health

Did you know that **April is Oral Health Month?** This is a great time to provide a lesson, activity, or unit on the importance of good oral health practices for students. Interior Health's <u>Dental Health Program</u> has compiled resources into a toolkit for teachers to easily incorporate into their math, science, art, or health education curriculum.

Elementary School:

The Canadian Dental Hygienists Association website, <u>Dental Hygiene Canada</u>, is a resource for general oral health education; they provide colouring sheets, word searches, and <u>printable activity sheets</u>.

The Canadian Dental Association website includes experiments and activity sheets for children.

<u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> offers an <u>activity book</u> with interactive ways to talk to children about caring for their teeth.

Elementary and Middle School:

The American Dental Association website, <u>Mouth Healthy</u>, has the Smile Smarts Dental Health Curriculum, which includes:

- flexible, modular <u>lesson plans</u>
- classroom <u>demonstrations/experiments</u>
- oral health classroom <u>activities</u>
- student <u>activity sheets</u>

Middle and Secondary School:

The <u>Dental Hygiene Canada</u> website contains resources about the oral health and general health risks associated with <u>tobacco use</u> and <u>vaping</u>.

<u>Mouth Healthy</u> has resources on the risks associated with <u>oral piercings</u>, education on the importance of <u>mouth guards</u>, and how to keep your teeth healthy if you are <u>sick or experience vomiting</u>.

All Ages:

Discussions about the oral and general health risks of sugar are valuable to have. Interior Health's <u>Sugar Sense Display</u>, supported by a <u>facilitator's guide</u>, can stand alone in a library or the cafeteria. The site also provides <u>nutrition education</u> and resources.
