New: The tracker used by ED physicians has been renamed to ED Physician Tracker.




The Home button reflecting the new ED Physician Tracker label:





How to Print Patient Labels (as requested by RIH ED)

ED physicians can print patient labels by selecting **ED Tracker** from their Home button.

- Select the **ED Tracker** option to print labels.





- Select a patient from the tracker.
- Select  to launch the Triage overlay screen.
- Select **Print Reg Forms** to generate the labels and/or forms.




New Patient Identifier Includes (Preferred Name)

To meet the Inclusive Patient Identifier requirements, patient's preferred name appears in brackets when available.

In addition, the gender colour coding has been removed from the trackers.


Chart Viewer is Now Accessible from the Main Banner

Column Headings & One-Click Patient List Sorting

Sort patients on the tracker by selecting a column header.


Patient Chart Improvements: ED Callbacks & Workload Items

New Auto-Select Visit Pop Up & Indicator


When searching for, then selecting a patient, MEDITECH now automatically displays the active inpatient account if one exists.
