

REGIONAL PERIOPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM (RPEP)

The Interior Health perioperative training program is a blended learning program that enables RNs and LPNs to work in the perioperative environment (within their respective/defined scopes). The Ministry, IH Surgical Network, and the Professional Practice Office have jointly approved the program to satisfy the advanced preparation required to work within the perioperative specialty.

The training program offers multiple streams: Operative Room, Gastrointestinal, Ambulatory Surgery, and Cesarean Section. All streams utilize a blended learning format with systematic integration of online and face-to-face learning, aimed to facilitate critical thinking within the context of perioperative care. The program uses a provincially standardized, evidence-informed online curriculum offered by the Association of Registered periOperative Nurses' (AORN) called, Periop 101.
