Rabies Post Exposure Prophylaxis (RPEP)

It's RPEP season again! With increased opportunity for the public to be in contact with bats and other wildlife, it is important to know the resources available to ensure patients that present to emergency departments in IH receive appropriate RPEP treatment and hand-over

to public health for continuation of rabies vaccine series.



The <u>Rabies Post-Exposure Prophylaxis</u> (<u>RPEP</u>) <u>Toolkit</u> is now available on the InsideNet Clinical Care Resources for Emergency & Trauma Care. This toolkit is a one-stop shop for the information needed when providing RPEP. It includes the <u>RPEP Pre-Printed</u> <u>Order Set</u> and the <u>RPEP Reporting Form</u>, which is completed and returned to public health for continuation of the rabies vaccine series.

How's your Tetanus?

Now is a good time to check your tetanus stock, to replace any that has expired and to ensure you have enough as we approach the summer months. Ordering is easy! Use the IH Publicly Funded Vaccine Order Form.

Has your site considered keeping a stock of age-appropriate tetanus containing vaccine on hand if a child requires tetanus for wound management? We have developed a <u>chart</u> to help determine which tetanus containing product is most appropriate according to age. Keep in mind the only time a family may be willing to immunize is following their child's injury in the emergency department. Use the IH <u>Publicly Funded Vaccine Order Form</u> to order!
